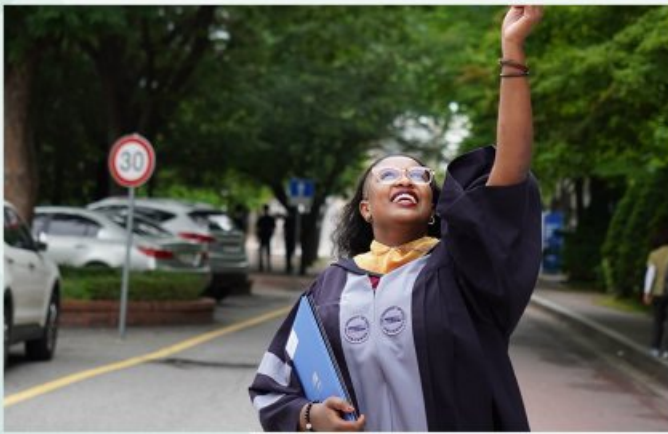

Master's Program for Future Global Leaders in Environmental Policy (MGLEP in short) is a full-scholarship Master's program with a focus on environmental management and policies. The program is funded by the Korea Ministry of Environment and Korea Environmental Industry and Technology Institute.

University of Seoul has been its hosting institution since the program was launched in 2015. It admits 22-27 students a year from around the world. Most of them are mid-career public officials dealing with environmental policies in their home countries. As it is a two-year program, we have well over forty MGLEP students in residence at any given time of the year.

As part of the program, MGLEP students academically engage in and out of the University through lectures and seminars, visit various sites in South Korea of environmental relevance, gain an internship experience in a Korean institution, learn the Korean language and culture as well as participate in further extracurricular activities.

If you have been working in the fields of environmental policy and sustainable development of towns and villages and if you are serious about expanding your intellectual capacity through cross-cultural learning, MGLEP might be the answer. Please join us!
