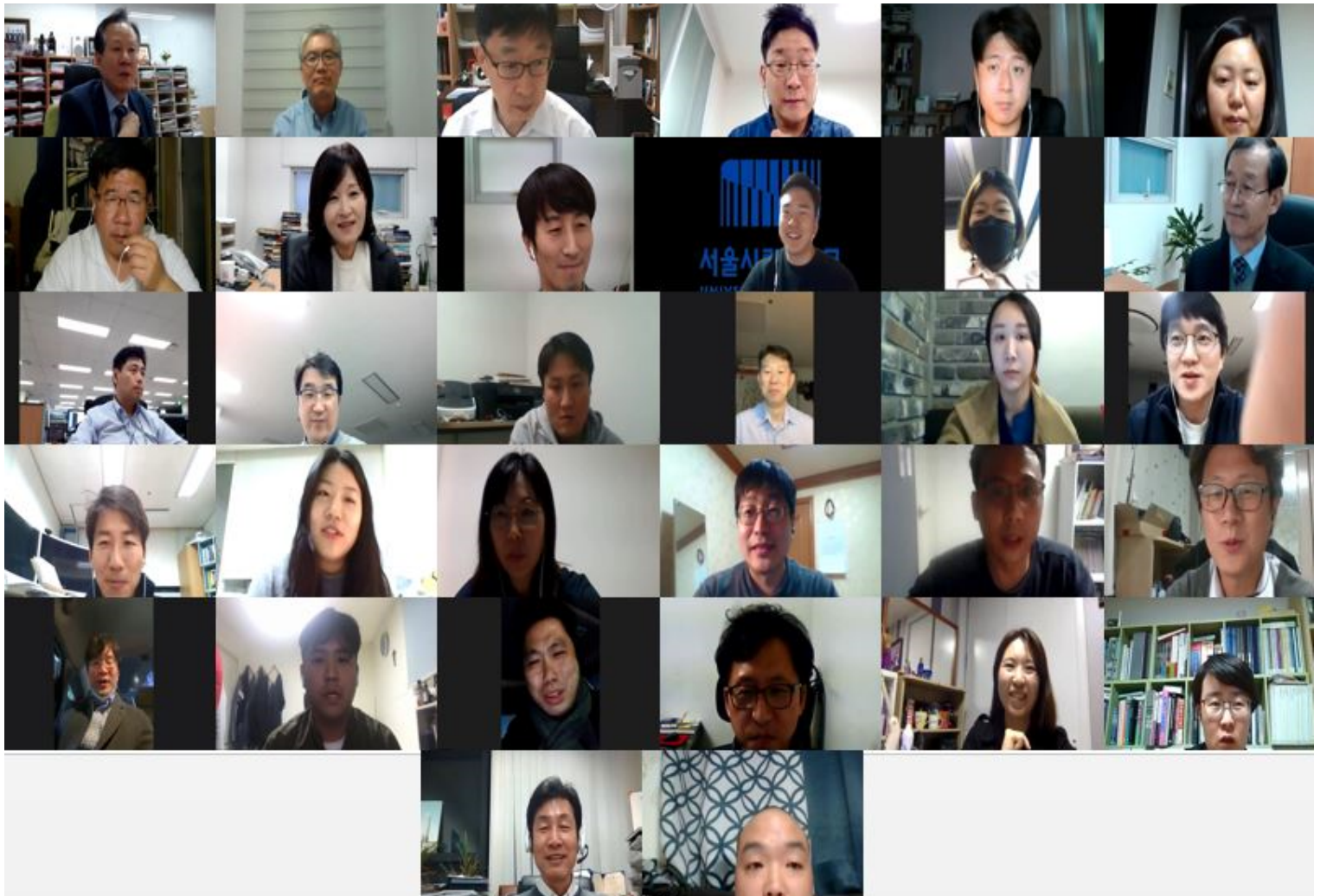

Online Opening Ceremony & UOS shift to Online Classes Spring Semester



As a precautionary measure regarding COVID-19, ISUS has initially decided to conduct spring semester online opening ceremony on April 13, 2020.

This measure comes as social distancing is the most effective way to prevent the cluster infections of corona virus.

As per the government's guidelines, ISUS should communicate with students

via online solutions during the social distancing period.

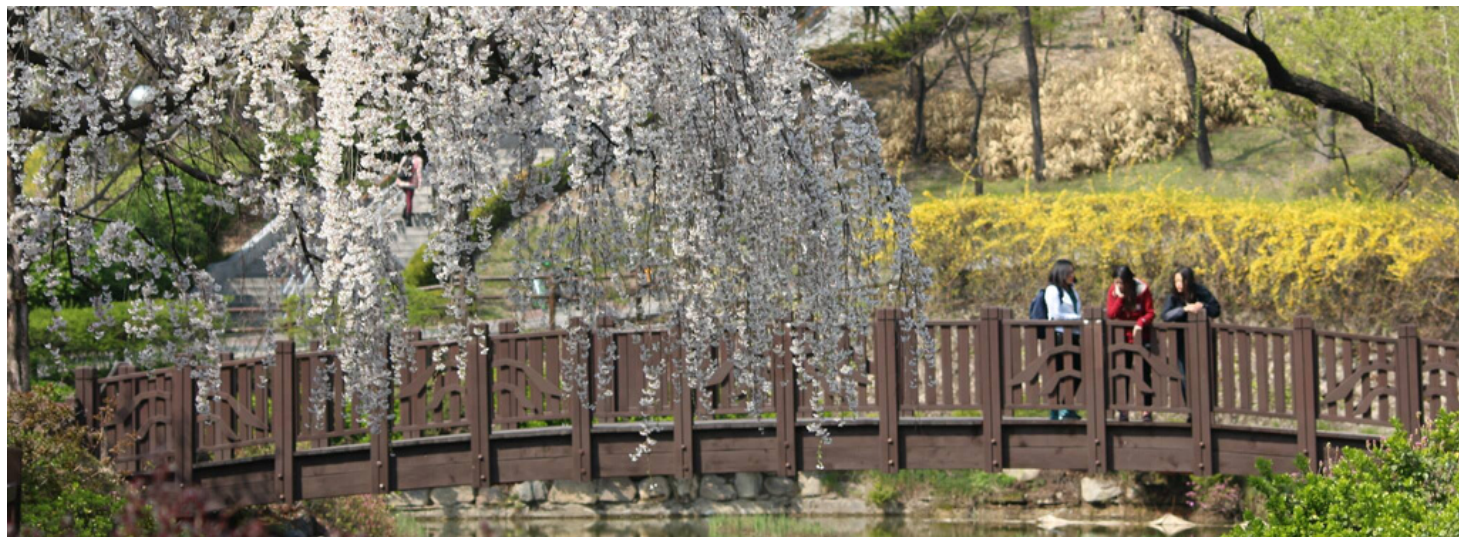

KOICA extended the application deadline to May 8, and expanded qualifications to private sectors in MURD Program

Due to COVID-19, KOICA announced that the application deadline for MURD program had been extended to May 8, 2020. Applicants must submit all the documents to the regional KOICA office or Korean embassy. After the document review, the online interview will be held from May 27 to June 10, 2020. Applicants, who have passed the first round of evaluation, will go through regional medical check-up. KOICA will announce the final list of successful applicants for admission on June 26, 2020. The MURD program starts in mid-August 2020.

Furthermore, KOICA expanded the qualifications to the private sector for the 2020 MURD program. It now allows applicants with more than five years of experience from urban and regional development-related areas, private universities (faculties) or private research institutes, or non-government organizations or international agencies officially registered in target countries.

Through the application period extension and qualifications expansion, KOICA and ISUS are looking forward to welcoming many competent applicants all over the world. 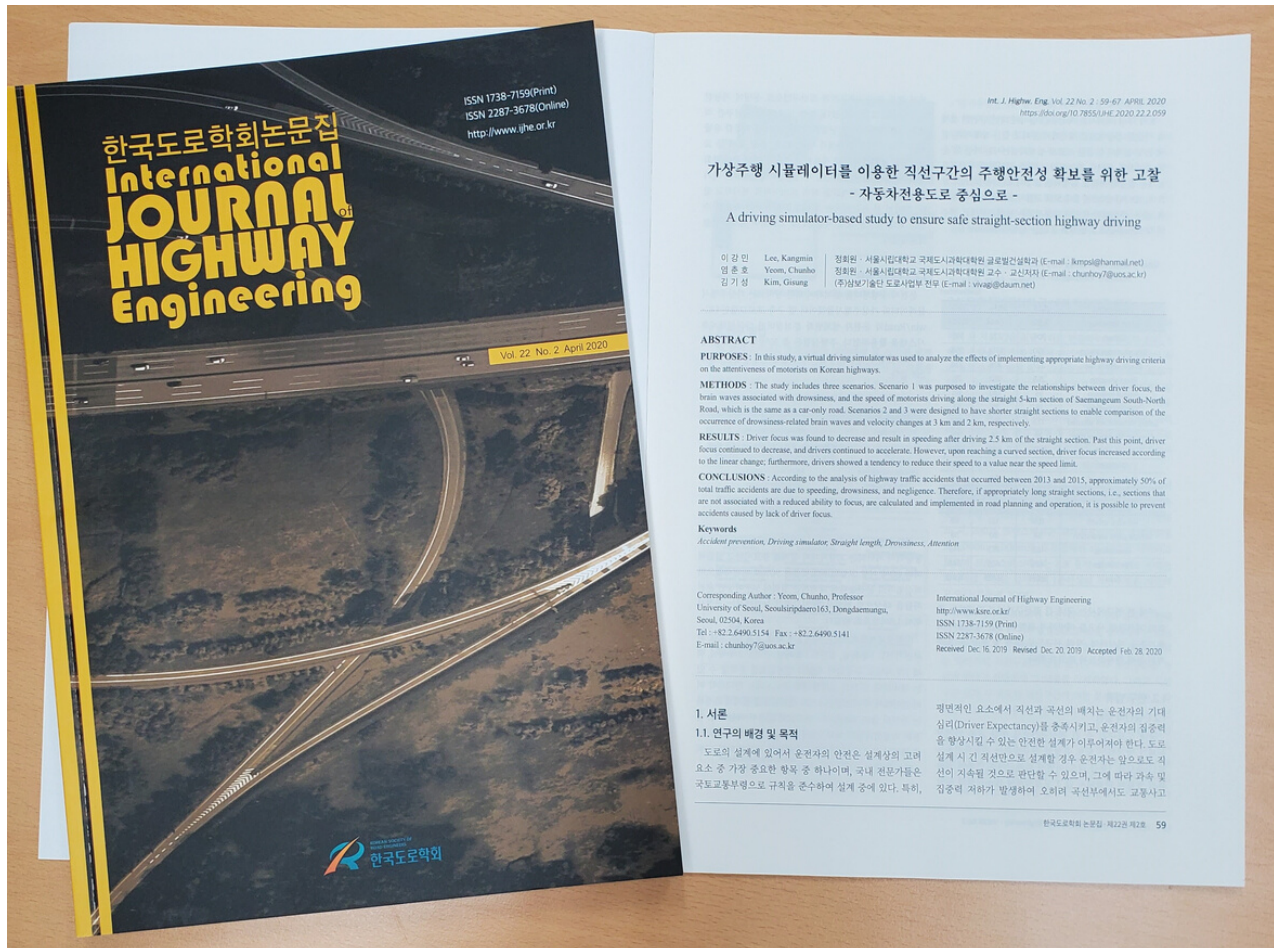

Publication in the KCI (Korea Citation Index) Journal



Mr. Kangmin Lee (Global Construction 6) and Professor Chunho Yeom published an article entitled "A driving simulator-based study to ensure safe straight-section highway driving" through the International Journal of Highway Engineering Volume 22. No. 2. Their report is on pages 59 to 67.

The abstract of the article is as follows:

In this study, the authors analyzed the contents of applying the appropriate straight length application criteria using the virtual driving simulator to prevent attention degradation related to long straight lines in Korea. The scenario consists of three scenarios. Scenario 1 examined the driver's attention deterioration due to drowsy brain waves and speed in the 5km straight section of Saemangeum South-North Road, which is the same as the car-only road. Scenario 2 and Scenario 3 reduced the length of the straight section to compare the occurrence of drowsy brain waves and velocity changes at 3km

and 2km, respectively. It was analyzed that the driver's attention decreased and caused overspeed from 2.5km when entering the straight section. When the straight section continued, the driver's attention continued to decrease and caused overspeed. On the other hand, when entering a curved section, the driver's attention improved according to the linear change, and at the same time, the driver showed a tendency to drive near the speed limit by decreasing the speed. According to the analysis of highway traffic accidents in 2013-2015, traffic accidents of speeding, drowsiness, and negligence caused about 50% of the total traffic accidents. Therefore, if an appropriate straight-line length that does not cause attention deterioration is calculated and applied to road planning and operating roads, it is possible to prevent accidents caused by drivers' attention deterioration.

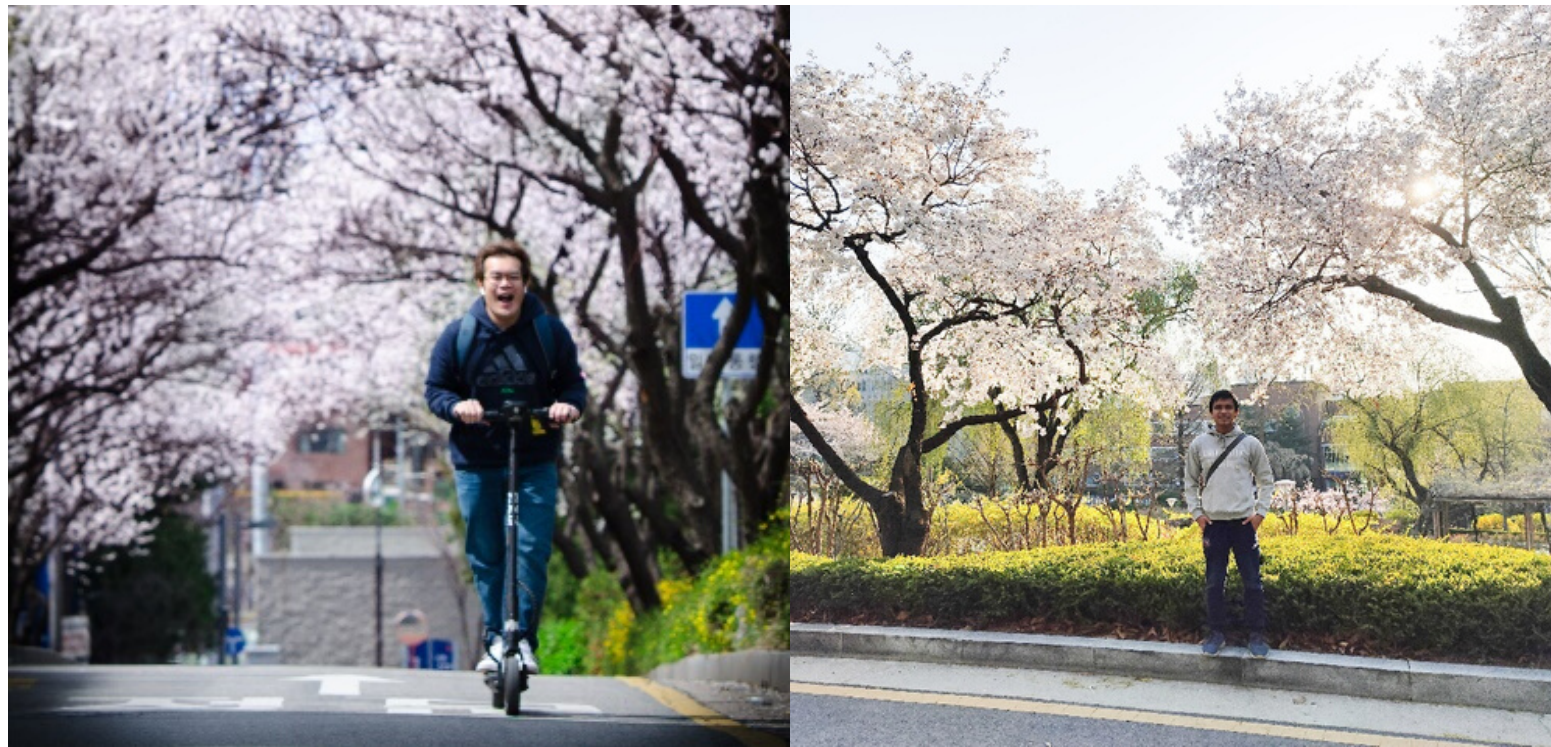
