ISUS resumes MURD Program in Fall 2020

The International School of Urban Sciences (ISUS) at the University of Seoul was re-selected as the host organization of the 'Master of Urban and Regional Development' (MURD) program. KOICA sponsors this program.

The MURD program aims to provide theoretical and practical education to formulate a long-term national comprehensive plan for the territory and regional development, including master planning, land use planning, real estate and housing development, urban redevelopment, and new town development. Also, the MURD program offers extracurricular activities such as field trips, workshops, conferences, and Internship/Job shadowing.

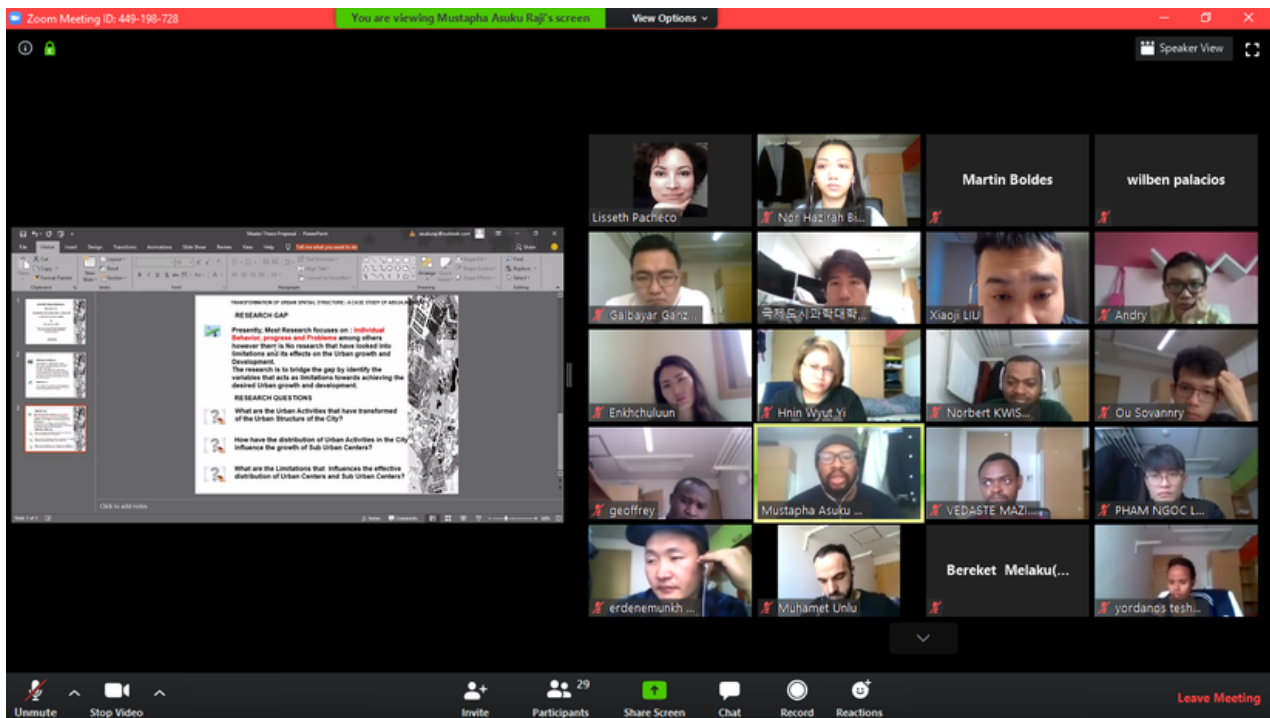
Starting in the first semester of Fall 2020, MURD will recruit twenty government officials from sixty-four KOICA's partner countries. The selected students will stay in South Korea for seventeen months until they finish the master's program. A master's diploma will be awarded in February 2022.

The application is due on April 15, 2020. Applicants must submit all the docu-

-ment review, an on-line interview will be held on May 6~15, 2020. Applicants, who have passed the first round of evaluation, will go through regional medical check-up. KOICA will announce the final list of successful applicants for admission on June 26, 2020. The MURD program starts in mid-August 2020.

UOS shift to Online Classes



As a precautionary measure regarding COVID-19, UOS has initially decided to conduct classes in distance education for the first two weeks of the spring semester. However, the period of the online-only class was extended from March 16, 2020, to May 8, 2020, to continue to ensure the health and safety of the campus community. This measure comes as social distancing is the most effective way to prevent the cluster infections of coronavirus.

As per the government's guidelines, professors and students are notified that they should teach and learn via online solutions during the remote learning period, and the online class might be extended further if COVID-19 infections persist.

During the period, professors and students are required to use EDU-CLASS as a primary route of communication. Class notices, materials, and assignments are shared through this platform. Also, UOS provides university members with ZOOM online chat program and GoToMeeting app for live online classes, sharing multi-media contents, and sharing Class materials.
